### FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER APRIL 28, 2024



Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend we begin our celebrations of First Holy Communion. Do you remember your First Holy Communion? As we see the children

and their love for Jesus in the Eucharist, are we inspired to keep up our piety? A good genuflection, a reverent sign of the Cross, a daily visit to the Eucharist each day...these are the little habits of child-like eucharistic piety that renew our Love for God.

There is no greater grace than to receive the Lord in the Holy Eucharist! Pope Benedict called the Eucharist the "banquet of the reconciled." If we have heard the Gospel message of love and repented of our sins, we can then approach the banquet. After being reconciled with the Lord in the sacrament of confession, we can make a fruitful communion. St. Paul gives us a loving warning in his First Letter to the Corinthians:

"So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat the bread and drink from the cup. For those who eat and drink without discerning the body of Christ eat and drink judgment on themselves (1 Cor. 11:27-29)."

This teaching gives us a holy fear and humility before the Eucharistic Lord. Examining ourselves--which is difficult to do--will lead us to be reconciled and confidently approach the banquet. There is an old saying that we ought to "treat sacred things in a sacred way." May the Lord grant us a "sense of the sacred" before the Eucharist--it is truly Him! May we always treat Him with responsible love.



St. Patrick's Organ Repair


